



## PGI Italian MST Racing (Thoroughbred & Harness)

### Wagering menu & rules

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#### Current pools offered:

**Win** (first place finisher(s)) *€1 minimum*

**Place** (first second or third place finisher(s) race) *€1 minimum* (see table below for place runner rules\*)

**Exacta** (first and second in exact order) *€1 minimum*

**Trifecta** (first, second and third in exact order) *0.20c minimum*

#### Current wagering rules after early scratchings\*

Pool	Number of Horses
Win	2 or more runners
Place *	1-4 runners = no place dividends 5-7 runners = 2 place dividends 8 runners or higher = 3 place dividends
Exacta	3 or more runners
Trifecta	4 or more runners

***With later scratchings after "open," pools are left in the field drops under the amount of entries to complete the wager. For example, in a field of four with a late scratch and fails to come out of the gate and only three start, the exacta would be refunded.***

#### Dead Heats

Pool	Dividend Split
Win	The Net pool shall be divided into as many equal portions as there dead heaters and each resultant portion divided by the number of unit bets on the individual dead heaters.
Place	For the purpose of the calculation of Dividends, horses dead heating for first place shall be deemed to have filled the first and second places, horses dead heating for second place to have filled the second and third places, horses dead heating for third to have filled third and fourth places and horses dead heating for fourth to have filled fourth place jointly.**

	<p>Whenever a dead heat between two horses results in the payment of more place Dividends than is provided for in the place rule table * the Dividends payable shall be calculated as follows:</p> <p>The Net Pool shall be divided into so many equal portions as, but for the dead heat, there would have been places *</p> <p>The Dividends on the horses not involved in the dead heat shall be calculated as per **</p> <p>The remaining portion shall be divided into two equal parts, which shall respectively be divided by the number of unit bets on each of the horses in the dead heat.</p>
<b>Exacta</b>	<p>The Net Pool shall be divided into as many equal portions as there are possible dead heat combinations and each resultant portion shall then be divided by the number of unit bets wagered on those winning combinations.</p>
<b>Trifecta</b>	<p>In the Event of a dead heat resulting in more than one winning combination, the Net Pool shall be divided into as many equal portions as there are winning combination and each such portion shall then be divided by the number of unit bets on each of the combinations.</p> <p>In the Event of a dead heat for the First place between two horses they shall be deemed to have run First and Second, Second and First. There shall therefore be two winning combinations. Should three or more horses dead heat for First place there shall be as many winning combinations as there are possible combinations.</p> <p>In the Event of a dead heat for Second place between two horses they shall be deemed to have run Second and Third, Third and Second. There shall therefore be two winning combinations. Should three or more horses dead heat for Second place there shall be as many winning combinations as there are possible combinations.</p> <p>In the Event of two or more horses dead heating for Third place there shall be as many winning combinations as there are dead heaters.</p>

## Carry Overs

Any pools with no winning tickets will be carried over (NET amount) and added into the next same pool in the next race. If there are any carry overs left at the end of the meeting, they will be added in to the next available meeting into the same pool.
