York regular **Master Milliner** has a winning mentality, while **Zoffee** and **Mellow Magic** are closely matched on Newcastle form. In a competitive handicap, the tentative suggestion is the Northumberland Plate third **SOLENT GATEWAY**.

The Champagne Stakes winner **BAYSIDE BOY** has been highly tried – Vertem Futurity, French Guineas and St James's Palace Stakes - over 1600m, so is fancied to make the most of an ease-in-grade to record a third career win. **Checkandchallenge**, who looked to be a potentially useful prospect when winning the Burradon Stakes at Newcastle in April, is a worthy adversary.

The mighty Battaash has dominated the King George Qatar Stakes in recent times, winning four-years in succession between 2017 and 2020. He clocked a quicker time every single year, winning in 55.62 seconds in 2020.

Age is no barrier to success in this race, as demonstrated by Borderlescott (aged 8; 2010) and Take Cover (aged 9 for the second of his two wins in 2016.)

Charlie & Mark Johnston are doubly represented with **Loyal Touch** and **Trojan Legend**, while **Scorch** (a \$600,000 breeze-up purchase) and **Runaholic** are the most intriguing of the newcomers. Nevertheless, it's difficult to ignore the clear promise shown by the Dubawi colt **CLASSIC** on debut (fourth) at Newbury. Richard Hannon's 260,000gns yearling promises to be much wiser for that initial introduction to racing.

A consolation race for the Stewards' Cup, in which the recent Newmarket scorer **LETHAL LEVI** is an obvious selection. He competes under a 6lb penalty (3lb well-in; due a 9lb rise). **Dream Composer**, **Treacherous** (the 2020 winner) and **The Lamplighter** have all demonstrated the undulations of Goodwood suit, while an underperforming **Stone of Destiny** is dangerously handicapped. The Epsom Dash fourth **Mokaatil** also enters calculations.

The Lancashire Oaks second **Sea La Rosa** boasts a fine strike-rate (5-12) but does take a leap into the unknown in terms of stamina on her first attempt at 2800m. She is a progressive filly though and will be a popular choice among punters.

Aidan O'Brien's **EMILY DICKINSON** is at an earlier stage of her career (as a three-year-old) but, after meeting trouble in-running, was finishing strongly over today's trip in the Stanerra Stakes at Leopardstown. **Forbearance**, who has endured a disappointing season, was three places in behind in fifth. The selection has since run a perfectly respectable race (fourth to Magical Lagoon) in the Juddmonte Irish Oaks.

Ed Walker's **Glenartney** was a narrow winner of the Listed Pontefract Castle Fillies' Stakes, but whether she's capable of holding her own in a stronger Group 2 contest remains to be seen. Rain would undoubtedly aid the cause of **Urban Artist** – runner-up in the Summer Handicap last year – while it is asking plenty of the Camelot filly **Yesyes** to make a winning seasonal reappearance.


